# SCVL Ratings Changes

Everything you need to know... Beginning Spring 2024

## Rating Expiration

To help ensure ratings are accurate and refreshed,

**SCVL** ratings will expire after three years

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR ME?

All players must participate in a pre-season rating session at least once every three years to stay current

## Rating Challenges

So we can accommodate as many players as possible, SCVL players can challenge/pre-qualify to challenge their rating only once every two seasons

### WHAT IS PRE-QUALIFICATION FOR?

## When your current rating does not adequately reflect your skill

## **Evaluation Notice Process Changes**

Any player placed on Evaluation Notice must attend a rating session at the beginning of the next season they play

To ensure time to make arrangements to attend, players will be informed of their Evaluation Notice during the latter half of each season

## Developmental Subdivision (DS) Category

Each SCVL Division will include a Developmental category Players in this category must refresh their rating at the beginning of each season to confirm skills

For Spring 2024:

All players with a rating in the lowest 10% of each Division: will be considered Developmental
